



Recycling Carts

Description

The City of Cohoes applied for grant funding from the NYS Department of Environmental Conservation and The Recycling Partnership in effort to provide new 65-gallon recycling bins to the residents of Cohoes. New bins would address concerns of missing or damaged bins that are often overfilled with recyclables. The new rolling bins would give residents a significant upgrade in recycling capacity and durability in effort to foster a Cleaner Greener Cohoes. Along with the addition of the recycling carts, the City of Cohoes is planning a multi-phase education and outreach program to inform and engage residents about positive recycling practices, as well as celebrating residents who are doing their part.
