



White Street and Pocket Park

Description

The White Street and Pocket Park project is a planned expansion of streetscape projects similar to the one that began on Remsen Street. The White Street streetscape intends to help map out the revitalization of the historic business district in Cohoes by improving walkability through sidewalk replacement and fostering greater accessibility to the downtown area in an environmentally conscious way.

The White Street project also supports the inclusion of a Pocket Park on the corner of White Street and Remsen Street. The park will be fitted with bike racks, seating, seasonal plantings, and a mural, among other things. Street trees will fit the theme of the existing streetscape design on Remsen Street.

Funding was secured in 2019 for the Urban Connectivity Plan, which funded the plans for many streetscapes projects including the project at White Street and Pocket Park.
