



Urban Connectivity Plan

Description

The Urban Connectivity Plan is a planned expansion of streetscape projects similar to the one that began on Remsen Street. Upcoming streetscape plans intend to help map out the revitalization of the historic business district in Cohoes by improving walkability through sidewalk replacement and fostering greater accessibility to the downtown area, all while promoting healthy living characteristics through greater access to trail systems in an environmentally conscious way. This grant funding allows for the planning of streetscape designs for the following:

- Ontario Street (Ogden Mills to Cohoes Boulevard(787));
- White Street (Mohawk Street to Main Street);
- Howard Street (Mohawk Street to Main Street);
- A Pocket Park on the corner of White Street and Remsen Street; and
- A Pedestrian Path connecting Mohawk Street and Canvass Street.
